Dear Shipper,

We hereby want to inform you regarding new import customs regulations for export cargo to the European Union.

All bills of lading information of containers from non-EU ports must be submitted to EU customs authorities **24 HOURS BEFORE LOADING INTO THE VESSEL**. This EU customs law enters effect from the B/L date: 1 January 2011.

In reality, for export cargo booked on Seatrade vessels, we need you to submit your shipping instruction (aka b/l instruction) before friday 12:00pm. The Seatrade vessel comes mostly every Tuesday and we need to key in the data into the system and submit it on Friday pm latest because of the deadline. Also, in case the Seatrade vessel might come on Monday due to circumstances, we are still on time with the customs declaration.
